Rescue Squad Park Picnic Shelter Policies and Procedures

Rescue Squad Park Picnic Shelter is available for reservations at times not designated for recreation programs/public use. Reservations can be made for 2 hour blocks. Reservations may be made by contacting Lincoln County Parks and Recreation at 704.483.8980 during the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Reservation applications must be signed by a person at least 21 years of age and the person signing the application will be responsible for the conduct of the group in compliance with the Policies and Procedures of the park. **Payment must be received within 7 days of making the reservation, or reservation may be canceled.**

The Rescue Squad Park Management Committee reserves the right to cancel any reservation which is not in the best interest of the County and the Community.

Full day reservations must be approved by the Rescue Squad Management Committee and are only considered under extraordinary circumstances.

Any group not complying with the Policies and Procedures of the park will not be considered for future use of the facility.

No affixed decorations are allowed on the structure of the shelter or the walls.

No alcoholic beverages, fireworks, or weapons are allowed on the premises.

Sales of Goods and merchandise are prohibited. Exceptions may be made if approved by the park management committee, when the proceeds of such sales are to be used for charitable, educational, church, civic or cultural purposes.

Please remove all trash and personal belongings (food, equipment, etc.) by the end of the time of your reservation. Trash receptacles are located throughout the shelter.

Please report damage or problems to the Lincoln County Parks and Recreation Department at 704.483.8980. The person signing the application is responsible for the condition of the facility and all damages. If no answer, please leave a message or if IMMEDIATE attention is needed, call the Lincoln County Communications Center, non-emergency number 704.735.8202.

In making this facility available to sponsors and the general public, Rescue Squad Park Management Committee, Denver/Lake Norman Rotary, Lincoln County, and its Officials and employees shall be held harmless and shall assume no responsibility or liability for any loss or damage which may occur upon the premises of the Park during the use of the premises as governed by the policies and procedures.

Lincoln County Sheriff's Department has full authority to enforce all the regulations pertaining to Rescue Squad Park.
